Submitting proposals will be made through the congress website (www.cieci.es):



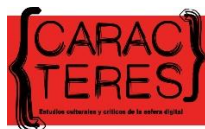
Authors must register on the website and follow the instructions contained therein. An author may submit only a single communication to the congress. The payment of the registration fee allows the presentation of a single communication regardless it is individual or collective. CIECI only will include in the congress proceedings and certifications the names of collective communications authors who are up to date with their congress fees.

Publishing

The titles, abstracts and keywords of the communications will be published through the methaodos.org research group congress web (OCS). The complete text of all the communications which surpass the evaluation through a blind peer review procedure will be published in the congress proceedings. Finally, those communications that obtain a better evaluation by the CIECI will be published as an article in an ordinary number of scientific journals that have reached a collaboration agreement with the congress. The selected communications should be adapted to the article format that the journal's standards provide.
